Special Visitor

You are welcome to stand in the back or along the side of the gym.

Bus Evacuation Practice

To comply with standards that require the practice of emergency evacuation from school buses, the Transportation Department intends to conduct bus evacuation drills on Thursday, February 7th and Friday, February 8th. On February 7th, students who ride the bus home at 3:38 will practice. ECSE and Special Education students who attend the morning session will practice on February 8th. Because of these practices, your child's bus may arrive home about 15-20 minutes late on these dates.
