LPS Portal for Student Information

We don't want you to miss out on staying connected with our school and receiving valuable information from your child's teacher! Helping your child be successful is our goal and the best way to achieve this goal is to create a strong partnership between you and our teachers through communication.

ParentVUE is a secure, private website through Lincoln Public Schools that allows families access to their child's real-time information. ParentVUE allows you to track attendance, see class websites, view report cards, access Special Education documents, access schedules, grade book information, course history and more! Next school year, you will be able to verify your child's enrollment information through the parent portal without having to go through countless paper forms.

How can you sign up?

Please contact the office if you did not receive your Activation Key information in the most recent Thursday Folder. This is a very important step to set up your secure account. Once you have the key from our school office staff, you can create an account. If you have already received a ParentVUE activation letter from your school, it contains the activation key that you need.

Next, please follow the steps below to activate your account:

1. In a browser, go to <https://synergyvue.lps.org>
2. Click "I am a parent"
3. Click "More Options" and then click "Activate Account"
4. Read the "Privacy Statement" and click, "I Accept"
5. Enter your name and activation key exactly as they appear in your activation letter from the school, and click "Continue to Step 3"
6. Choose a username and password, provide an email address and click "Complete Activation"
