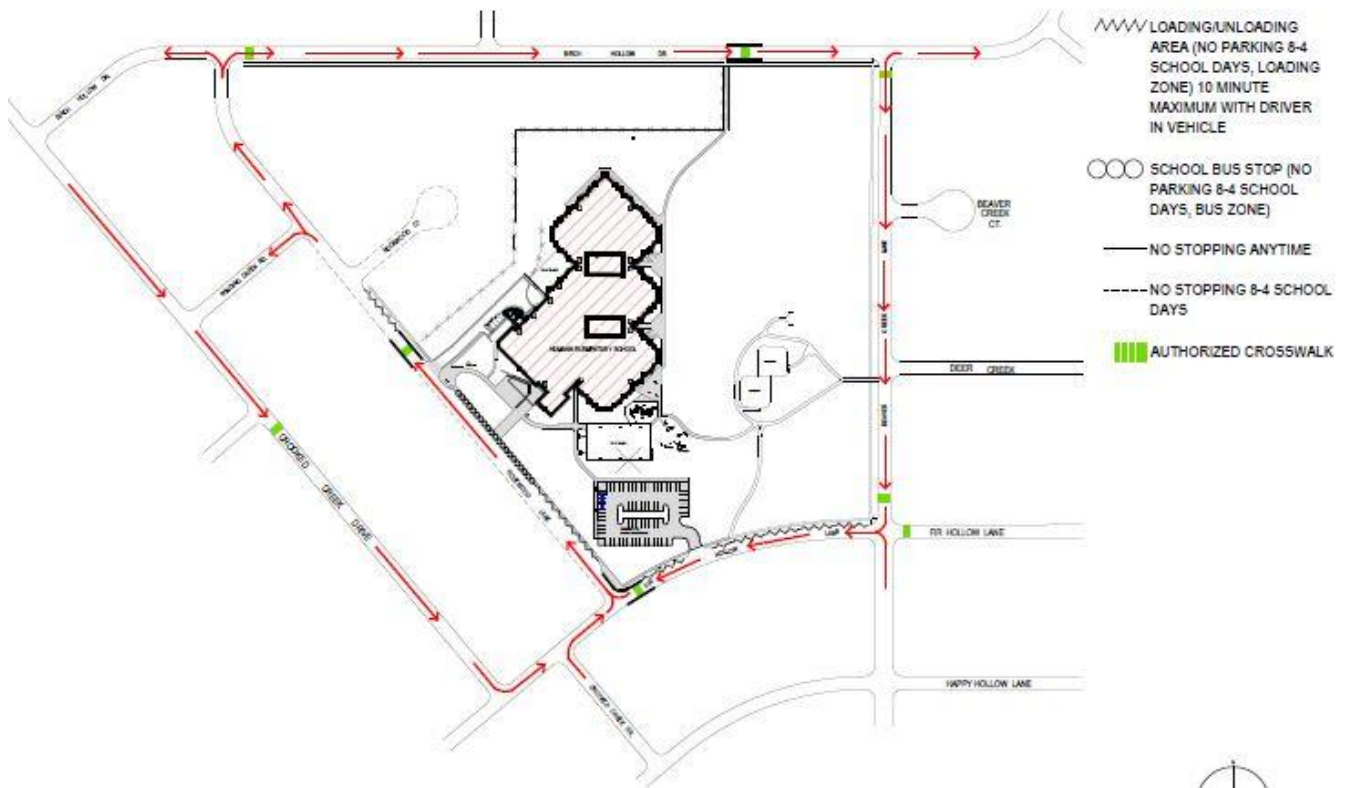

Humann Elementary School has the opportunity to participate in the Food BackPack Program. This program is made possible through partnerships with the Food Bank of Lincoln and Humann Elementary School. There will be 33 Fridays during the school year that a backpack filled with items such as cereal, canned fruit or vegetables, tuna helper, peanut butter and jelly, or mac n' cheese will be sent home for your family. Your child will be responsible for picking up the backpack on Fridays and bringing the backpack back to school on the following Monday. A voucher for a carton of eggs and a loaf of bread will be sent home approximately 6 times throughout the school year. A voucher for half a gallon of milk will be sent home approximately 8 times. These can be redeemed at any Russ's Market, Super Saver, or Save Best grocery store in Lincoln. If you would like to participate in the program please sign and return this form to the school office. If you have any questions or need a paper copy to be sent home with your child please contact Anitra Lechtenberger in the office.

Please be aware that our school will only be able to select 20 participants for the program. We will work very hard to meet the needs of all families who show interest.
